

# Call For Abstracts

Abstracts are invited for Free Communication and Poster Presentation for the UGSA 2019 Annual Scientific Meeting. Abstracts are welcome on any topic relevant to female pelvic floor dysfunction. Abstracts will be selected according to scientific merit. Abstracts should be submitted by the presenting author. Only one author per abstract can be nominated as the 'presenting author'.

## ABSTRACT PREPARATION GUIDELINES

### 1 Length and Structure

- A maximum of 750 words excluding title will be accepted. Word count does not include tables and two references (tables limited to two).
- Abstracts should be structured to contain objectives, methods, results, conclusions or recommendations.

### 2 Layout and Format

- Each abstract must be prepared in Microsoft Word. No other formats will be accepted.
- The title of the abstract should be written in sentence case i.e. initial capital letter, followed by lower case.
- List details of the author/s name/s (surname followed by initial of first name with a comma separating each author). Name of the presenting author must be asterisked (\*).
- List author/s affiliation/s (organisation, city, state, country), separated by commas. Author/s and affiliation/s to be linked by a superscript number.
- Please note that double spacing should separate the title, author/s name/s, affiliation/s and body of the text.
- Please refrain from using printed enhancements such as italics, underlining, bold text etc. Italics may be used for non-English words or scientific names where necessary.

### 3. Video Abstract

## ABSTRACT SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

- CLOSING DATE FOR ABSTRACT SUBMISSION IS FRIDAY 21st December, 2018.
- All paper based abstracts are to be submitted via an on-line portal on the UGSA ASM website. Visit: [www.ivvy.com/event/ASM19](http://www.ivvy.com/event/ASM19) and click on the Abstract and Travel Scholarship tab to submit your abstract on-line.
- Abstracts should be submitted by the presenting author. Only one author per abstract can be nominated as the 'presenting author'.
- All submissions must be accompanied by a maximum 80 word biographical paragraph of the presenting author. Biographical details will be used by the session chair for introductions purposes and may also be published in meeting literature.
- You will be given the option to have your abstract available online through the Members page on the UGSA website.

**Please ensure you have the following required information available before beginning the online abstract submission process:**

- Your contact details.
- The title of your abstract
- Preferred presentation type (Free Communication and/or Poster Presentation).
- Name and organisation of your co-author/s, if applicable.
- Your (the presenting author's) brief biography (maximum 80 words). Biographies are to be written in full sentences (not dot points) and in third person.
- Your abstract prepared in the format specified under Abstract Preparation Guidelines
- 10 Abstract submissions will be chosen for Poster Presentations at UGSA ASM.
- The best 9 abstracts will be selected for oral presentation.
