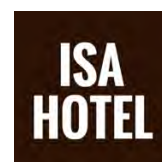

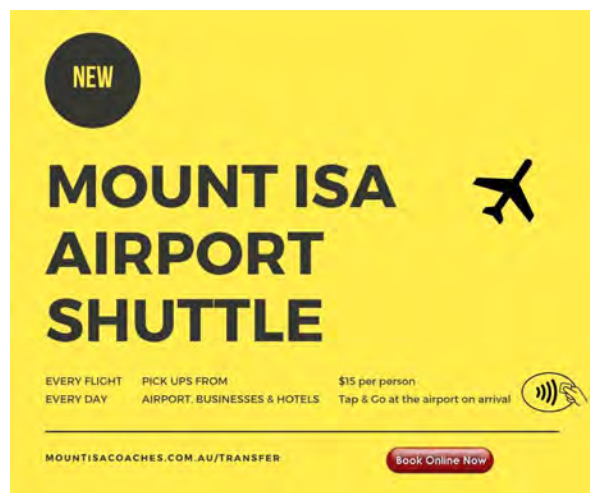

The progressive city of Mount Isa is the most important industrial, commercial and administrative centre in outback Queensland, the second largest state or territory in Australia.

Situated 977 kilometres west of Townsville, Mount Isa is an important railhead; has an airport with facilities for Jets and is a key road hub for the extensive system of highways linking Brisbane, Townsville, Alice Springs and Darwin.

Mount Isa began as a mining town, following the discovery in 1923 of substantial deposits of lead. It is now one of the world's top ten producers of copper, silver, lead and zinc. Development has kept pace as prosperity increased and the city has grown to be a modern, well-appointed centre of approximately 22,000 people.
